**RE:** Mileage Rate Decrease for 2010

The Internal Revenue Service has announced that the personal motor vehicle standard mileage reimbursement rate will be **\$.50 per mile**, effective January 1, 2010.

In accordance with OCGA 50-19-7, the State of Georgia follows the mileage reimbursement rates set by the United States General Services Administration (GSA) for federal employees. The GSA is prohibited by law from exceeding the IRS rate, and likewise, is also expected to lower its rate effective January 1, 2010.

Accordingly, the current mileage rate policy will be amended to reflect the new vehicle mileage rate of \$.50 per mile for travel that occurs on or after January 1, 2010.
