## What compensation information will employees view in GA@WORK?

Employees can easily view components about their compensation. This includes their Total Salary & Allowances, Total Base Pay, Total Compensation, any One-Time payments, and the overall Compensation Package.

## Are there any compensation terminology changes that impact all employees?

- Salary admin plans will now be called compensation grades.
- Grades are now grade profiles.

## What is the same between GA@WORK and TeamWorks about compensation?

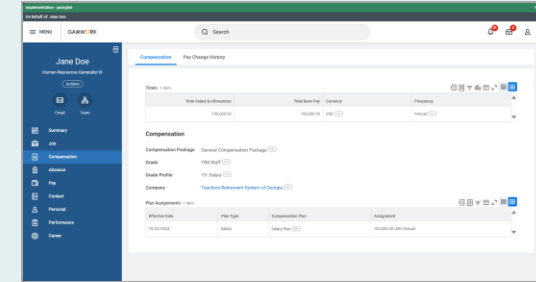
- Employees can set their payment elections, which allows them to designate how they want to receive payroll and expense payments.
- “Compensation component” is an umbrella term for compensation packages, grades, grade profiles, and plans.

## Do employees view their pay slip in GA@WORK?

Yes, employees can view their pay slip at anytime in GA@WORK.

## How does salaried non-exempt employees compensation look on their profile?

When an employee is assigned to a non-exempt job but is paid an annual salary, their total salary and allowances shows their annual salary as an hourly rate but at the bottom of the screen, they can view their true annual salary under “plan assignments.”
