

## **Deleting Favorites**

Step	Action
1.	<ul> <li>My Favorites allow users to navigate directly to frequently visited pages alleviating the need to remember the full navigation paths to find those pages.</li> <li>If a user finds they no longer want a particular Favorite saved, they can delete it in My Favorites in TeamWorks.</li> <li>To delete a favorite previously, navigate to My Favorites.</li> </ul>
2.	To delete a <b>Favorite</b> let's begin by using the <b>NavBar</b> located in the top right corner of the <b>Home</b> page. Click <b>NavBar</b> .
3.	Click My Favorites.
4.	Click Edit Favorites.
5.	The Edit Favorites page displays the user's favorites in a grid format that can be updated.Note: Favorites are directly linked to the user, so they are able to enter unique descriptions and change sort order.
6.	<ul> <li>Users can delete a favorite that is no longer needed by clicking in the checkbox next to that particular Favorite. Updates must be saved to confirm the deletion.</li> <li>Note: If the user wants to delete all of the Favorites saved, simply click the checkbox next to "*Favorite" to select all.</li> </ul>

7.	For this example, the user wants to delete <b>Benefits Summary</b> .
	Click the <b>Checkbox</b> to delete the <b>Benefits Summary</b> favorite link.

8.	Click Delete Selected.

9.	A Delete Confirmation message displays. The user should click Yes to confirm they want
	to delete the selected favorite link or click <b>No</b> if they do not.
	For this example, click <b>Yes</b> .

10.	Deleting a favorite will not change the sequence numbers for any remaining favorites. If a
	new sort order is wanted, the changes will need to be made manually.
	Note: Refer to the Adding Favorites topic for further information on setting the Sequence
	numbers for favorites.
11.	The user must <b>Save</b> the changes for the updates to be completed.
	Click the <b>Save</b> button.

12.	Now, let's verify the <b>My Favorites</b> list has been updated.
	Click the <b>NavBar</b> icon.
