

Selective Service Status

If you are a male, 18 through 25 years of age, you must present proof of having registered with the Selective Service System or of being exempt from registration. Georgia State law (O.C.G.A 45- 20-20) requires all males 18 through 25 years of age to present proof of having registered for the Selective Service System or of being exempt from such registration.

Please verify Selective Service status by checking the appropriate statement below and signing your name. You will be required to show documentation to verify your status.
