FR.gov Enhancements for April

❖ Bulk Commenting - Excel Upload Capability

- As requested by Federal Agencies technical representatives
- Provides a batch upload mechanism that allows Agencies to update single or multiple reports with comments and/or mark reports as 'Reviewed with No Comments'.

❖ Email - Add Award IDs to Subject Line

- As requested by State technical representatives
- Adds the Award ID to the subject line of emails sent to report recipients who submitted reports via the Excel and XML batch submission processes.
- Note: the single exception is for reports submitted via single file upload (Excel, XML files) that fail validation/submission; these emails will contain the name of the upload file instead of the Award ID.

FR.gov Enhancements for April, cont'd

❖ **Comments in Continuous QA Agency Notification Email**

- As requested by the Department of Energy
- During the Continuous QA period, FederalReporting.gov sends out a nightly email to agency users listing the reports that recipients updated during the previous day. This email will now also include a list of comments that were added by agency reviewers.

FR.gov Enhancements for April, cont'd

❖ Requirements for Sub Award Data

- As requested by State technical representatives
- In prior reporting periods, when batch XML files were submitted with the Sub-Award Number, Sub-Award Amount, and Sub-Award Date left blank, FederalReporting.gov was not sending an error message/email and the file was not appearing in the completed file on the FTP server.
- FederalReporting.gov will now issue an error message when this occurs. Each of these fields is required and should not be blank when submitting a report as/for a sub recipient.
